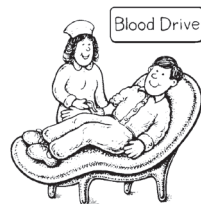

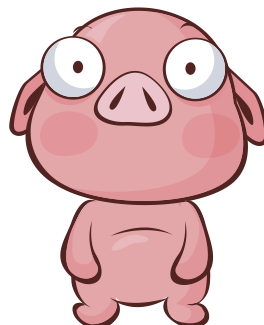
Submit the expenses to our Worthy Financial Secretary and before you leave the meeting that night you will get reimbursed for the expenses.
